All fabrics are from Nordic Christmas by Fabric Freedom

Requirements

| 1. FF190-1 | Penguins and Stripes | 1/4 yard – 25cm |
| 2. FF191-1 | Icicles | 2 yard – 1.85 mtr |
| 3. FF192-1 | Stripes | 1/2 yard – 50cm for the binding |
| 4. FF193-1 | Penguins | 1/4 yard – 25cm |
| 5. FF194-1 | Hearts | 1/2 yard – 50cm |
| 6. FF195-1 | Checks | 1/2 yard – 50cm |
| 7. White | | 1.1/8 yard – 1 mtr |

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut three 6.1/2" squares

From fabric 2 cut twelve 3.7/8" squares, and twenty four 3.1/2" squares

From fabric 3 cut backing fabric. (two 33" length across the width of fabric and sew

From fabric 4 cut twenty four 3.1/2" squares

From fabric 5 cut and piece 2.1/2" strips: two 80.1/2" and four 24.1/2" for border

From fabric 6 cut twelve 3.7/8" squares

From fabric 7 cut thirty six 3.1/2" squares, twenty four 3.1/2" by 6.1/2" rectangles and twenty four 3.7/8" squares

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

Sewing



Make half square triangle units with the 3.7/8" squares. Place two squares with right sides together and mark a line along the diagonal. Sew a 1/4" seam either side of the marked line and cut along the line to produce two half square triangle units.

Use four squares each of fabrics 6 and white together.

Use four squares each of fabrics 2 and white together.

Lay the patchwork pieces out as shown.

Sew the rows to each other to complete the block. Make three of these blocks.

Finishing the Nordic Christmas Table Runner

Sew the blocks together with the four fabric 5 short strips, then sew the two longer lengths of fabric 5 to the top and bottom.

For the backing you will need a piece 56" by 25" of both backing fabric 3 and wadding.

For the binding, sew the six strips of fabric 3 together to give one very long strip to make the binding.
