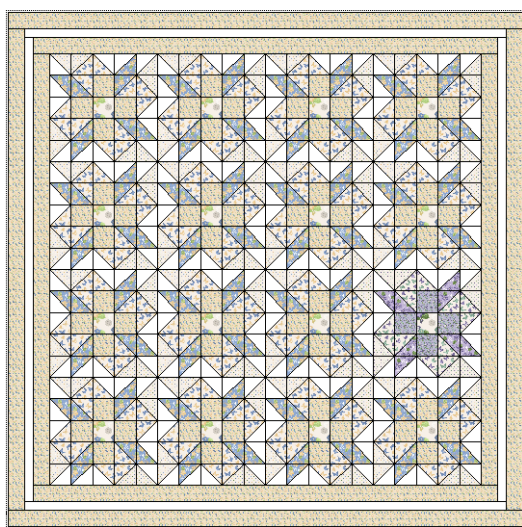

## **Birds and Butterflies Quilt Three** **Designed by Hazel Jeffrey**

**Size 71" x 71"**

All fabrics are from Birds and Butterflies by  
Fabric Freedom

| 1. FF242-3 Birds and Butterflies | 3/4 yard – 70cm      |
| 2. FF243-3 Large Flowers         | 1.1/2 yard – 1.4 mtr |
| 3. FF244-3 Butterflies           | 1.1/2 yard – 1.4 mtr |
| 4. FF245-3 Dots                  | 1/2 yard – 50cm      |
| 5. FF246-3 Small Flowers         | 1/2 yard – 50cm      |
| 6. White                         | 1.1/2 yard – 1.4 mtr |
| 7. For the backing use fabric 1: | 2.1/4 yards – 2.3mtr |
| 8. For the binding use fabric 1: | 1/2 yard – 50cm      |

You will also need a piece of wadding approximately 75" square.

### **Cutting**

From fabric 1 cut sixteen 3.1/2" squares

From fabric 2 cut sixty four 3.7/8" squares.

From fabric 3 cut ninety six 3.7/8" squares.

From fabric 4 cut sixty four 3.7/8" squares

From fabric 5 cut sixty four 3.1/2" squares, cut and piece 2.1/2" strips: two 60.1/2" long, two 64.1/2" for border 1 and two 66.1/2" long, two 70.1/2" long for border 3

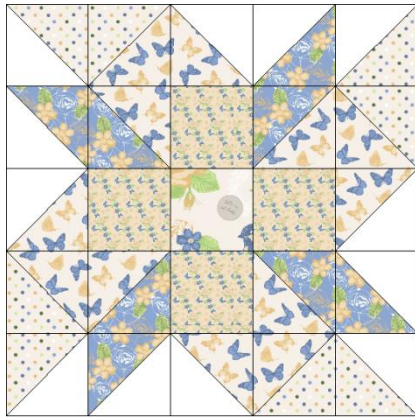
From fabric 6 cut ninety six 3.7/8" squares cut and piece 1.1/2" strips: 64.1/2" long, two 66.1/2" long for border 2.

For the backing cut two 75" length of fabric 1 across the width of fabric, trim selvage off and then sew together to create one large pieces 75" x 75".

For the binding cut six 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 1 across the width of fabric.

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

### **Sewing**



Make half square triangle units using the 3.7/8" squares in fabric 2 with either fabric 3 or 6 and also fabric 4 with either fabric 3 or fabric 6. Place two squares with right sides together and mark a line along the diagonal. Sew a 1/4" seam either side of the marked line. Cut along the line to produce two half square triangle units from each pair of squares.

Use two squares each of fabrics 2 and white together

Use two squares each of fabrics 2 and 3 together

Use two squares each of fabrics 3 and white together.

Use two squares each of fabrics 4 and white together.

Use two squares each of fabrics 4 and 3 together.

Lay the patchwork pieces out as shown.

Make sixteen of these blocks. Sew them together in four rows of four blocks.

### **Finishing the Birds and Butterflies Quilt**

For the border sew the two 66.1/2" lengths of fabric 5 to each side of the quilt and sew the two 71. 1/2" strips to the top and bottom.

For the backing fabric you will need 75" squares of both backing fabric 1 and wadding.

For the binding, sew the seven strips of fabric 1 together to give one very long strip to make the binding
