

Camping Quilt Two

Designed by Rose Smith of Ludlow Quilt and Sew

Size 46" x 46"

All fabrics are from Camping by Fabric Freedom

Please read through all the instructions before you begin

Requirements

1.	Caravans FF92-2	¾ yard – 70cm
2.	Bees FF93-2	1/2 yard – 50cm
3.	Flowers FF94-2	1/4 yard – 20cm
4.	Wigwams FF95-2	3/4 yard - 70cm
5.	Trees FF96-2	1/4 yard – 20cm
6.	White	1/2 yard – 50cm

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut sixteen 3.1/2" squares, sixty four 3.1/2" by 2" rectangles

From fabric 2 cut sixteen 3.1/2" squares. For the border cut two 2.1/2" strips 42.1/2" long, two 2.1/2" strips 46.1/2" long

From fabric 3 cut sixteen 3.1/2" squares


From fabric 4 cut sixteen 3.1/2" squares

From fabric 5 cut four 3.1/2" squares, sixteen rectangles 3.1/2" by 2"

From fabric 6 cut eighty rectangles 3.1/2" by 2"

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances.



Sewing

The quilt is made with four blocks and each block can be split into four quarters joined together by strips of squares.


Each quarter is made with three rows of three:

Row 1 is a fabric 4 (wigwam) square at each end with a square made of a white rectangle and a fabric 1 (caravans) rectangle sewn together between them.

Row 2 is a square made of the same 2 rectangles

at each end with a fabric 3 (flowers) square between them.

Row 3 is the same as row 1. Note that the 2 rectangles are sewn together so that the white is always along the edges of the central square. Sew the squares together across each row and then sew the rows to each other. Make 16 of these.



The full block is made with four quarters as above. Join the top two quarters with a strip made of two fabric 2 (bees) squares and one square made of a white rectangle and a fabric 1 (caravans) rectangle. Join the bottom two quarters in the same way, but note that the red squares are placed nearest the edge of the block.

Make a strip to join the two pairs of quarters together: two fabric 1 squares followed by a fabric 5 (trees) rectangle with white, then a fabric 5 square in the middle followed by another fabric5/white square and

then two fabric 1 squares. Sew the three rows together to complete the block. Make 4 blocks.

Assembling the Camping quilt

Sew the blocks into two pairs and then sew the pairs to each other.

For the binding, sew two fabric 2 strips 42.1/2" long to the top and bottom and two fabric 2 strips 46.1/2" long to the sides to complete the quilt.
