



## **Dream a Little Dream Quilt Three**

**Designed by Rose Smith of  
Ludlow Quilt and Sew**

Size 60" x 60"

All fabrics are from Dream a Little  
Dream by Fabric Freedom

Please read through all the instructions before  
you begin

### **Requirements**

| 2. Blender One FF202-3           | 3/4 yard – 70cm    |
| 3. Blender Two FF203-3           | 3/4 yard – 70cm    |
| 4. Arrows FF204-3                | 1 yard – 1mt       |
| 5. Feathers FF205-3              | 3/4 yard – 70cm    |
| 6. For the backing use fabric 2: | 3 yards – 2.75mt   |
| 7. For the binding use fabric 3: | 1/2 yard – 50cm    |

You will also need a piece of wadding approximately 64" square.

### **Cutting**

From fabric 1 cut seventy two 3.1/2" squares, thirty six 3.7/8" squares

From fabric 2 cut and piece 3.1/2" strips: two 54.1/2" wide and two 60.1/2" wide

From fabric 3 cut thirty six 3.7/8" squares (to pair with fabric 1) and eighteen 3.7/8" squares (to pair with fabric 5)

From fabric 4 cut thirty six rectangles 3.7/8" by 6.7/8", eighteen 3.7/8" squares

From fabric 5 cut thirty six rectangles 3.7/8" by 6.7/8"

For the backing cut one 64" length of fabric 2 across the width of fabric. Cut two 26.1/2" lengths of fabric 2 across the width of fabric.

For the binding cut six 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 3 across the width of fabric.

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

## Sewing



Make half square triangle units using the 3.7/8" squares in fabrics 1 and 3 and also in fabrics 3 and 5. Place two squares with right sides together and mark a line along the diagonal. Sew a 1/4" seam either side of the marked line. Cut along the line to produce two half square triangle units from each pair of squares.

Make half rectangle triangles with the rectangles in fabrics 4 and 5. Cut each rectangle along one diagonal and sew together one triangle of each to re form a rectangle.

Lay the patchwork pieces out as shown:

In the middle there is a 4 patch unit made with the fabric 3/5 half square triangles, placed so that the fabric 3 triangles form a central diamond. In each corner there's a 4 patch unit made with two fabric 1 squares and two fabric 3/1 half square triangles. On each edge of the central square there is a pair of half rectangle triangles. These are placed so that the fabric 5 triangles are side by side, forming a larger triangle pointing towards the central square.

Sew the pieces together within each 4 patch unit and sew the half rectangle triangles together in pairs. Each row now comprises three 6.1/2" squares. Sew the squares together across each row and then sew the rows to each other to complete the block. Make nine of these and sew them together in three rows of three.

## Finishing the Dream a Little Dream quilt

For the border sew the 54.1/2" lengths of fabric 2 to the top and bottom of the quilt and the 60.1/2" lengths to the sides.



For the backing fabric you will need 64" squares of both backing fabric 2 and wadding. The image shows one way that you could make the size (using 3 different colours only to illustrate the layout).

Sew the two 26.1/2" lengths of fabric 2 together along one short side. This will give you a panel 26.1/2" wide by 84" long. Cut this to 64" long. Sew this panel to the 64" strip of fabric along the 64" edge.

For the binding, sew the six strips of fabric 3 together to give one very long strip to make the binding.
