



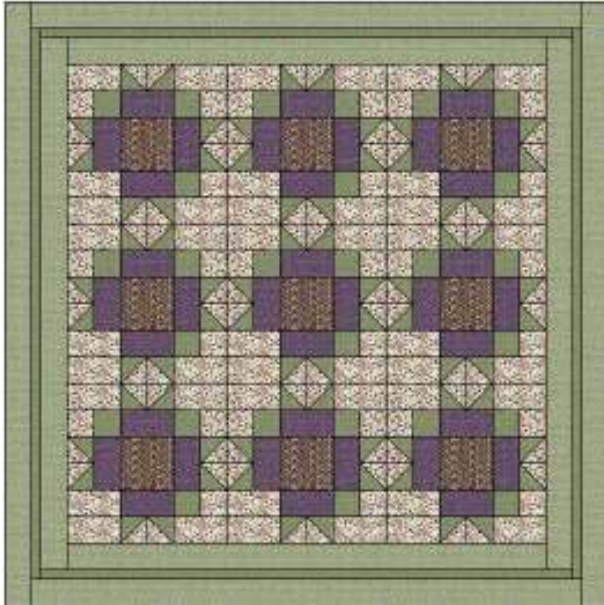
## Autumn Leaves Quilt Two

All fabrics are from Autumn Leaves by  
Fabric Freedom

### Requirements

| 1. Squirrels FF216-2             | 1.5 yard – 1.4mt   |
| 2. Blender One FF217-2           | 1.1/4 yard – 1.2mt |
| 3. Blender Two FF218-2           | 1.1/4 yard – 1.2mt |
| 4. Leaf blender FF219-2          | 3/4 yard – 70cm    |
| 5. Leaves FF220-2                | 1/2 yard – 0.5mt   |
| 6. For the backing use fabric 3: | 3.3/4 yards        |
| 7. For the binding use fabric 5: | 3/4 yard           |

You will also need a piece of wadding approximately 72" square.

### Cutting

From fabric 1 cut forty five rectangles 3.1/2" by 6.1/2", twenty seven 3.1/2" squares, thirty six 3.7/8" squares

From fabric 2 cut twenty seven 3.1/2" squares, thirty six 3.7/8" squares. For border 1 cut and piece 1.1/2" strips: two 60.1/2" long and two 62.1/2" long for border 2

From fabric 3 cut and piece 3.1/2" wide strips: two 54.1/2" long, two 60.1/2" long for border 1 with two 62.1/2" long and two 68.1/2" long for border 3

From fabric 4 cut thirty six rectangles 3.1/2" by 6.1/2"

From fabric 5 cut nine 6.1/2" squares

For the backing cut one 72" length of fabric 3 across the width of fabric. Cut two 30.1/2" length of fabric 3 across the width of fabric.

For the binding cut seven 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 5 across the width of fabric.

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.

## Sewing



Make half square triangle units using the 3.7/8" squares in fabrics 1 and 2. Place two squares with right sides together and mark a line along the diagonal. Sew a 1/4" seam either side of the marked line. Cut along the line to produce two half square triangle units from each pair of squares.

Lay the patchwork pieces out as shown:

Rows 1 and 6: two half square triangle units in the middle with a fabric 1 rectangle on either side.

Row 2: fabric 4 rectangle in the middle with a fabric 2 square on either side and a fabric 1 square at each end.

Rows 3/4: fabric 5 square in the middle with a fabric 4 rectangle on each side and a pair of half square triangles on each end.

Row 5: fabric 4 rectangle in the middle with a fabric 1 rectangle on the left and a fabric 2 and fabric 1 square on the right

Sew the pieces together across each row and sew the rows to each other to complete the block. Make nine of these. Sew them together in three rows of three.

## Finishing the Autumn Leaves quilt

For border 1 sew the two 54.1/2" lengths of fabric 3 to the top and bottom of the quilt and the two 60.1/2" lengths to the sides.

For border 2 sew the two 60.1/2" lengths of fabric 2 to the top and bottom and the two 62.1/2" lengths to the sides.

For border 3 sew the two 62.1/2" lengths of fabric 3 to the top and bottom of the quilt and the two 68.1/2" lengths to the sides.



For the backing fabric you will need 72" squares of both backing fabric 3 and wadding. The image shows one way that you could make the size (using 3 different colours only to illustrate the layout).

Sew the two 30.1/2" lengths of fabric 3 together along one short side. This will give you a panel 30.1/2" wide by 84" long. Cut this to 72" long. Sew this panel to the 72" strip of fabric along the 72" edge.

For the binding, sew the seven strips of fabric 5 together to give one very long strip to make the binding.
