Requirements

| 1. Large floral FF103-3 | ¾ yard – 70cm |
| 2. Small floral FF104-3 | 1/2 yard – 50cm |
| 3. Leaf stem FF105-3 | 1/2 yard – 50cm |
| 4. Paisley FF106-3 | 1/2 yard – 50cm |
| 5. Leaf in leaf FF107-3 | ½ yard – 50cm |
| 6. White | 2 yards – 1.9 m |

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut eighteen 3.1/2" squares, thirty six 3.7/8" squares for quilt block 1

From fabric 2 cut 2.1/2 strips: two 60.1/2" lengths, two 64.1/2" lengths for border 3

From fabric 3 cut fifty four 3.1/2" squares for quilt block 2

From fabric 4 cut 2.1/2" strips: two 54.1/2" lengths, two 58.1/2" lengths for border 1

From fabric 5 cut thirty six 3.1/2" squares for quilt block 2

From fabric 6 cut seventy two 3.1/2" squares, thirty six 3.7/8" squares for quilt block 1, seventy two 3.1/2" squares for quilt block 2, and two 1.1/2" lengths 58.1/2" long, two 1.1/2" lengths 60.1/2" long for border 2

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.



Sewing quilt block one

You will need two different quilt blocks for this quilt. Make half square triangles with the 3.7/8" squares. Place a fabric 1 and a white square with right sides together. Mark a line along the diagonal and sew a 1/4" seam either side of the marked line. This will give you two half square triangle units.

Lay the patchwork out as shown – four white squares, one fabric 1 square and four half square triangle units for each block. Sew the squares together across each row and then sew the rows together. Make eighteen of these blocks.



Sewing quilt block two

Lay the squares out in three rows of three to make a simple nine patch block. For each block you need four white squares, two fabric 5 squares and three fabric 3 squares. Sew the squares together across each row then sew the rows together. Make eighteen of these blocks.

Assembling the Funky Flowers quilt

Arrange the blocks in six rows of six blocks. For row one begin with quilt block 1 and then alternate with block 2 across the row. For row two begin with quilt block 2 and then alternate with block 1 across the row. Continue down the rows, alternating which block you begin with in each row. Sew the blocks together across each row and then sew the rows to each other.

For the first border, sew two 54.1/2" lengths of fabric 4 across the top and bottom of the quilt, with two 58.1/2" lengths down the sides.

For the second border, sew two white 58.1/2" lengths across the top and bottom of the quilt, with two 60.1/2" lengths down the sides.

Finally for the third border sew two 60.1/2" lengths of fabric 2 across the top and bottom of the quilt, with two 64.1/2" lengths down the sides.
