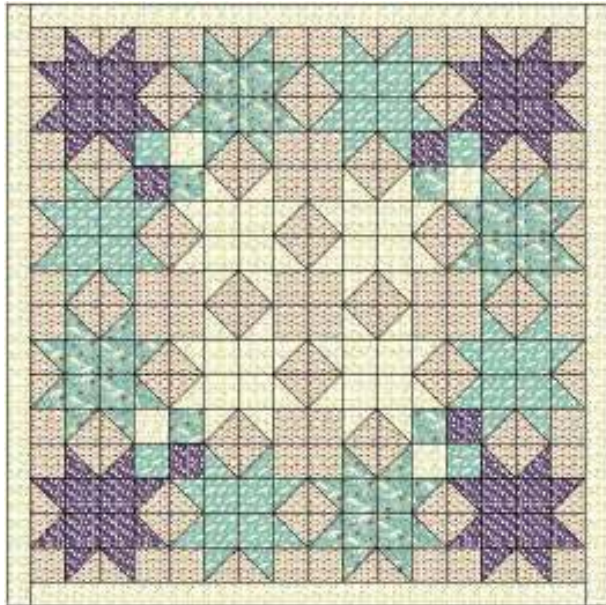

Requirements

| 1. Large floral FF123-1 | 1/2 yard – 50cm |
| 2. Yellow flowers FF124-1 | 1 yard – 1 m |
| 3. Flowers and leaves FF125-1 | 1/2 yard – 50cm |
| 4. Navy blue flowers FF126-1 | 1/2 yard – 50cm |
| 5. Bees FF127-1 | 1.1/4 yard – 1.2 m |

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut twenty 3.1/2" squares, sixteen 3.7/8" squares

From fabric 2 cut twenty 3.1/2" squares, sixteen 3.7/8" squares for the quilt blocks and two 2.1/2" lengths of 48.1/2", two 2.1/2" lengths of 52.1/2" for the border

From fabric 3 cut twenty 3.1/2" squares, sixteen 3.7/8" squares

From fabric 4 cut twenty 3.1/2" squares, sixteen 3.7/8" squares

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From fabric 5 cut forty eight 3.1/2" squares, sixty four 3.7/8" squares

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances.



Sewing each quilt block

Make half square triangles with the 3.7/8" squares. Place a fabric 4 (blue) square right sides together with a fabric 5 (bees) square. Mark a line along the diagonal and sew a 1/4" seam either side of the marked line. Cut along the line to produce two half square triangle units.

Lay the squares out in four rows of four: four fabric 4 squares in the middle and three fabric 5 plus one fabric 3 square in the corners. There are two half square triangles along each edge of the block, placed so that the bee fabric triangles form a larger triangle pointing towards the middle of the block.

Sew the squares together across each row and then sew the rows to each other to complete the quilt block. Make four blocks in this colour combination.

Make a further four blocks using fabric 2 for the star and fabric 1 for the single corner.

Make a further four blocks using fabric 1 for the star and fabric 2 for the single corner.

Make a further four blocks using fabric 3 for the star and fabric 4 for the single corner.

Assembling the Heritage Floral quilt

Arrange the blocks in four rows of four.

In row one place a fabric 4 star, fabric 1 star, fabric 3 star and another fabric 4 star. You will need to rotate the stars to make sure that the different coloured corners are placed to form a four patch unit between each pair of stars – check the quilt image.

In row two place a fabric 3 star followed by two fabric 2 (yellow) stars and a fabric 1 star.

In row three place a fabric 1 star followed by two fabric 2 stars and a fabric 3 star.

In row four place a fabric 4 (blue) star followed by fabric 3, fabric 1 and fabric 4 stars.

For the border, sew 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 2 (yellow) 48.1/2" long to the top and bottom of the quilt and 2.1/2" lengths 52.1/2" long to the sides of the quilt.
