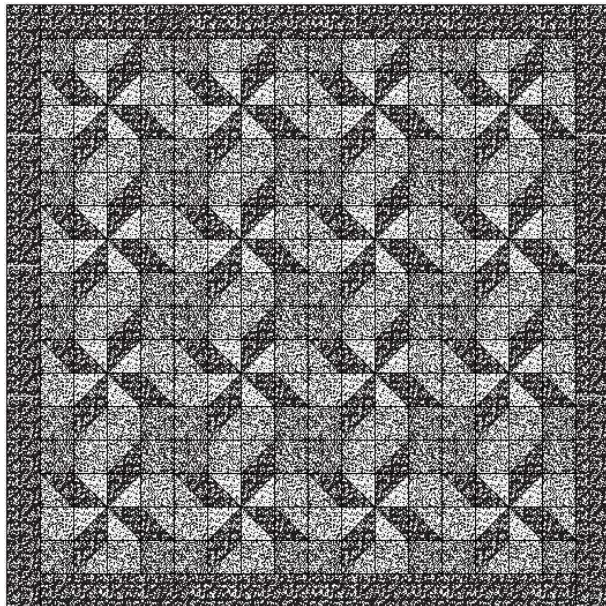

Requirements

| 1. FF155-1 | 1.1/2 yards – 135cm |
| 2. FF156-1 | 3/4 yard – 68cm |
| 3. FF158-1 | 1 yard – 90cm |
| 4. FF159-1 | 1/2 yard – 45 cm - plus 1/2 yard for binding |
| 5. FF157-1 | 2.1/2 yards – 225cm - for the backing |

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut sixty four 3.7/8" squares, two 3.1/2" by 48.1/2" strips, two 3.1/2" by 54.1/2" strips

From fabric 2 cut sixty four 3.1/2" squares

From fabric 3 cut sixty four 3.1/2" squares, thirty two 3.7/8" squares

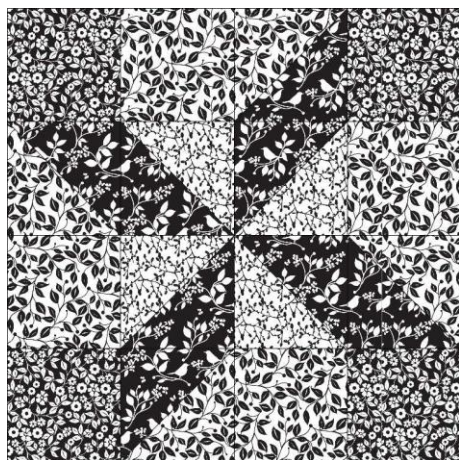
From fabric 4 cut thirty two 3.7/8" squares

For the backing cut one 58" length of fabric 5 across the width of fabric. Cut two 16.1/2" length of fabric 5 across the width of fabric.

For the binding cut five 2.1/2" lengths of fabric 4 across the width of fabric.

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

Sewing



Make half square triangle units with the $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Place two squares with right sides together and mark a line along the diagonal. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam either side of the marked line and cut along the line to produce two half square triangle units.

Use two squares each of fabrics 5 and 1 together.

Use two squares each of fabrics 4 and 1 together.

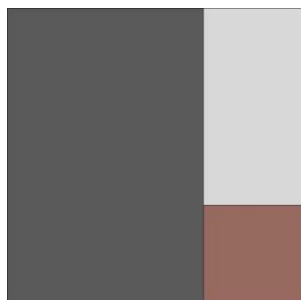
Lay the squares out in four rows of four. The pinwheel in the middle of the block is made with four fabric 1/5 half square triangle. The corners are fabric 2 squares. Along each edge place a fabric 4 square and a fabric 4/1 half square triangle unit.

Sew the squares together across each row and then sew the rows to each other to complete the block.

Make sixteen of these blocks. Sew them together in four rows of four blocks.

Finishing the Silhouette quilt

For the border sew the two shorter lengths of fabric 1 to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew the two longer lengths of fabric 1 to the sides.



For the backing fabric you will need 58" squares of both backing fabric 5 and wadding. The image shows one way that you could make the size (using 3 different colours only to illustrate the layout).

Sew the two 16.1/2" lengths of fabric 5 together along one short side. This will give you a panel 16.1/2" wide by 84" long. Cut this to 62" long. Sew this panel to the 62" strip of fabric 5 along the 62" edge.

For the binding, sew the five strips of fabric 4 together to give one very long strip to make the binding.
