



## Nutcracker Table Runner Colour One

Designed by Hazel Jeffrey

Size 62" x 24"

All fabrics are from Nutcracker by Fabric Freedom

Please read through all the instructions before you begin. All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

### Requirements

| 4. FF143-1                       | Stripes    | $\frac{1}{4}$ yard – 25cm |
| 5. FF144-1                       | Canes      | $\frac{1}{2}$ yard – 50cm |
| 6. White                         |            | $\frac{3}{8}$ yard – 40cm |
| 7. For the backing use fabric 1: |            |                           |

You will also need a piece of wadding approximately 66" x 28" rectangle.

### Cutting

From fabric 1 first cut two 28" pieces the width of the fabric remove the selvedge and sew together to make a 66" by 28" rectangle from the remaining fabric cut six 6.1/2" X 3.1/2" rectangles and six 3.1/2" x 6.1/2" rectangles

From fabric 2 cut twelve 3.7/8" squares and twelve 3.1/2" squares

From fabric 3 cut twelve 3.1/2" squares, for the inner border cut four 18.1/2" x 1.1/2" strips and two 58.1/2" strips.

From fabric 4 cut three 6.1/2" squares.

From fabric 5 cut twelve 3.7/8" squares, for the outer border cut and piece 2.1/2" strips: two 20.1/2" and two 62.1/2" strips.

From fabric 6 cut twenty four 3.7/8" squares

## Sewing

### Block 1



Make half square triangle units using the  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares in fabric 2 with fabric 6 and also fabric 5 with fabric 6. Place two squares with right sides together and mark a line along the diagonal. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam either side of the marked line. Cut along the line to produce two half square triangle units from each pair of squares.

Use four squares each of fabric 2 and fabric 6 together

Use four squares each of fabric 5 and fabric 6 together.

Lay the patchwork pieces out as shown.

Sew the rows to each other to complete the block. Make three of these blocks.

### Finishing the Nutcracker Table Runner

Sew the blocks together with the four fabric 3 short strips, then sew the two longer lengths of fabric 3 to the top and bottom.

For the outer border sew the two 18.1/2" strips to each end and then sew the 62.1/2" strips to the top and bottom.

For the backing you will need a piece 66" by 28" of both backing fabric 1 and wadding.

For the binding, sew the five strips of fabric 1 together to give one very long strip to make the binding.
